**Allergen Wine Advice** - We are required to inform you of food and drink we sell that has a sulphur dioxide (sulphates, SO2) content above 10mg. Per kilo or litre. Sulphites are present in almost all wines, as a preservative. It is used in winemaking, because of its antioxidant and antibacterial properties. SO2 plays a very important role in maintaining a wine's freshness. Without it, most wines would not keep. We have checked our wine list and the labels, and all state that sulphites are present, as they must above 10mg. levels. 'Organic' wines usually have no added sulphur dioxide, but it is created naturally anyway in the fermentation process. The actual amounts in each bottle we don't know, but as a guide the average is about 80 mg. /litre. Red wines need less sulphites and an average of about 50mg. Is likely. White wines more, around 120mg. And sweet white wines especially, with up to 350mg. per litre.
